 Engineering, Engingeering Technology, Environmental Sciences, Computer Science, Business/Commerce

Awards will be based on:

- Academic merit
- Leadership and community involvement

Students will be required to reapply for the scholarship each year. Qualified students are eligible to receive a maximum of four SEED Scholarship awards.
